MITTOR ON THE YEARTS ACTIVITIES.

The year ending on 31st March, 1984, marked a watershed in the activities of the Trunt. The year saw the setting up of The Revolving Fund Committee whose main objective is to identify historic buildings which are under threat from neglect or proposed demolition, and to take positive action to make them.

The terms of reference for the new Committee are as follows:-

"To pelect muitable projects for the Trust to carry out, including communicationing feasibility studies and subsequently to prepare fully costed recommendations for the Council of Management to consider."

The Trust consed to give grants for the repair and restoration of historic bulldings, except in special circumstances, and this duty reverted to the County Council. The Trust was gratified by the manner in which the grant-diding of these buildings has been carried out and would congratulate the officers concerned, who also happen to be members of the Trust.

The Technical Advisers continue to give specialist advice to the owners of historic buildings and new hope to those wilting under the pressures of ownership.

The 1983 Annual General Meeting was held in Nottingham Castle by kind permission of the City Council. Surrounded by the artistic treasures of the Council the 72 members and friends present were given an illustrated talk on the history of Newstead Abbey by the local expert, Dr. Rosalys Coope.

The News:Tetter has been published in its new format and has continued to find and report on original information and comment. The Trust welcomes contributions on all subjects related to historic buildings and hopes that this lively standard can be maintained.

The Technical Advisers were again invited to comment on almost two hundred planning applications during the year. These concerned buildings in Conservation Areas and those listed as being of architectural and historic interest. From the subsequent notification of the planning decisions made, the Trust was pleased to note that notice had been taken of the views expressed. Often design drawings were amended following reports made by the Technical Advisers.

The work of measuring and recording buildings has again been disappointing, mainly because of the lack of volunteers to do the work. However, a meparate team has been engaged in the national survey of Farm Bulldings, led by Mr. J. Severn, and as a result, the work in the County has been particularly dynamic in this direction. Mr. Severn has also been recording and restoring Dovecotes throughout the County and his greatest success has been at Barton-in-Fabis. This exceptional 17th century bullding contained banks of nesting boxes constructed of locally mined gypaum. The building and its nesting boxes have now been restored with the assistance of the Nottinghamshire County Council and Bultrah Gypaum, and will be open to the public in due course.

During the year the Trust entered into an agreement with the City Council to acquire and restore a Victorian cottage known as No.3 Green's Gardens, Sheinton. The cottage is part of an overall scheme which Includes the restored Green's Windmill, and the dwelling will be eventually used as a residence for the caretaker of the complex.

It is hoped that the work of buying, repairing and re-selling restored buildings will expand under the initiative of the Revolving Fund Committee.

The Trust has now prepared, with the assistance of the District Councils, an up-to-date list of Buildings at Risk throughout the County. This is the first time that such a comprehensive survey has been made. The next step is to follow up and report on each building with recommendations as to how each building can be saved and brought back into active use according to the individual problem involved.

The Trust would wish to record its thanks to all those who have freely given their time and advice to the work of the Trust throughout the year.
