REPORT ON THE YEAR'S ACTIVITIES

The year ending on 31st March, 1987 marked the end of twenty years life of the Building Trust, which was originally founded in February, 1967, coinciding with the passing of the Civic Amenities Act, under which Conservation became a legal activity.

The two Revolving Fund Committees have continued to operate in a positive manner. The Register of Buildings at Risk is now as up-to-date as possible and this remains the key resource from which decisions can be made.

114/116 St. Stephens Road, Sneinton was restored and offered for sale, 34 High Street, Arnold was restored, in a joint venture with the owner. No. 73 Main Street, Papplewick was repaired and renovated throughout and, in the North of the country, Warden's Cottage, Misson was acquired by the Trust, having stood empty and derelict for as long as the Trust has been in existence.

The Trust has also been engaged in studies concerning the future of Ollerton Hall and St. Stephens Church, Bobbers Mill.

The 1986 Annual General Meeting was held at Kelham Hall, Newark. Following the business meeting, an illustrated talk was given by the Chairman, Professor M.W. Barley, in which he described some of the research he had recently carried out in connection with his latest book.

The Technical Advisers were invited to comment on one hundred and twenty two planning applications during the year and gave written and verbal evidence at three planning appeals. The Technical Panel met on four occasions, to discuss policy and other matters affecting historic buildings and the environment.

The Trust involuntarily marked its anniversary by moving from the Old Bowls Pavilion, West Bridgford to new offices nearby, at 78, Bridgford Road. This now becomes the registered office of the Trust.

During the year, a new series of meetings was held, on a monthly basis, at which members were invited to bring their slides and show and discuss them. This was intended to be a social occasion, when members could meet each other and to which all new members were particularly invited. The first meetings were held at Langar Hall, by the kind invitation of Mrs. I. Skirving and were very successful.

The Annual Coach Trip was a tour of buildings designed by Robert Smythson - Barlborough Hall, Worksop Manor Lodge and Shireoaks Hall. The last two buildings are owned by good friends of the Trust, who also provided some very lavish refreshments. Even admirers of Robert Smythson continue to learn from visits to his buildings and this trip inspired some very interesting discussion, as well as being an enjoyable event in itself.

The Trust likes to visit buildings not generally open to the public and any suggestions as to future visits are always welcome.

The revision of the Listed Building Register was largely completed during the year and the Trust advisers made some contributions towards this. The work of establishing an archive of historic buildings within the County has not proceeded as well as was hoped and a volunteer, to help co-ordinate this work, is desperately needed.
