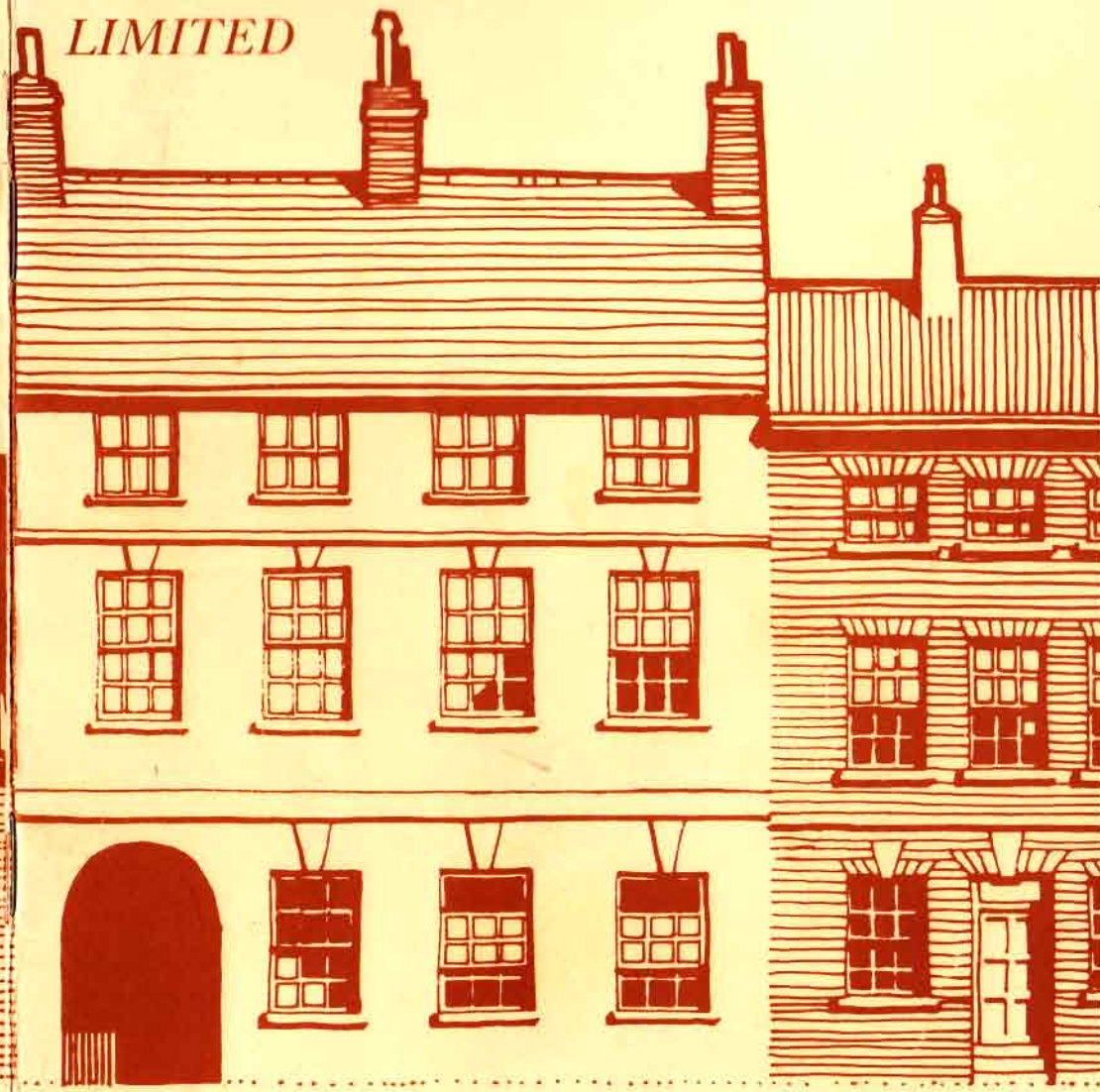
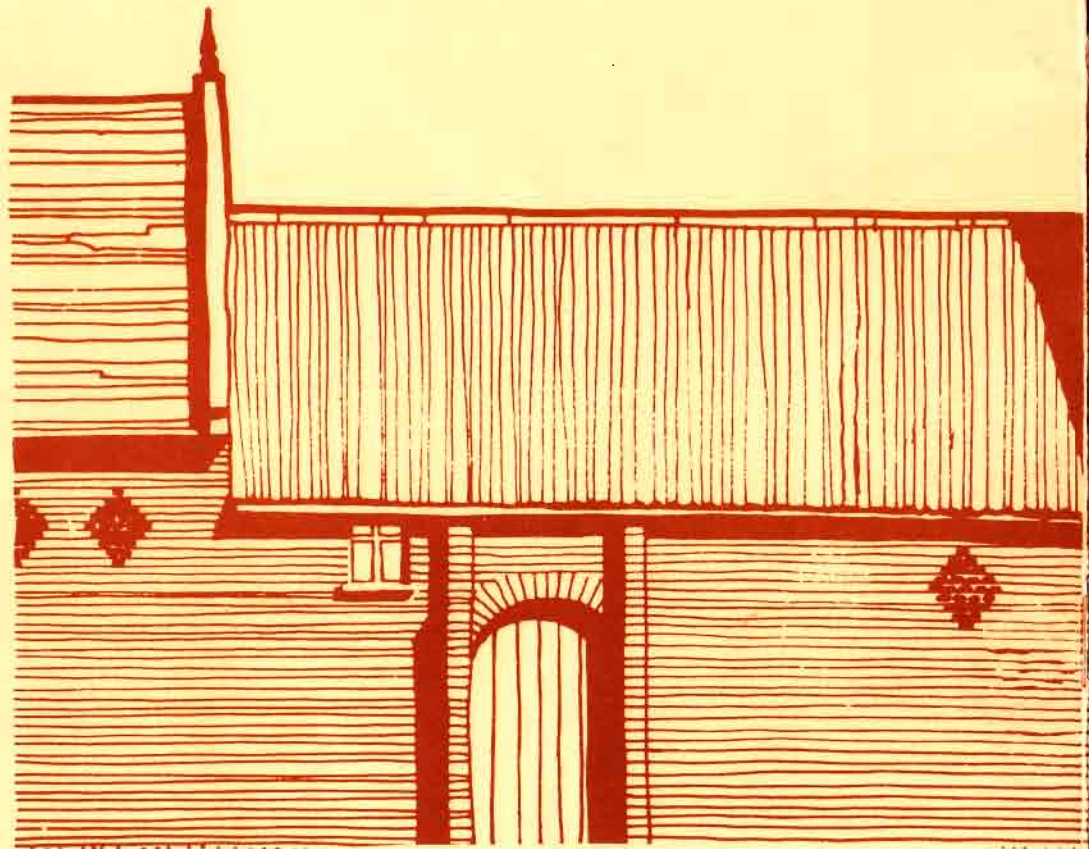

REPORT ON THE YEARS ACTIVITIES:

The year ending 31st March, 1986, was marked by an increase in the work of the Revolving Fund Committees, both in the north and south of the County.

The Committees are involved in compiling a list of historic buildings at risk from development, neglect or under the threat of demolition from either or any reason.

Each building is examined, in some cases a feasibility study is commissioned, and owners or developers are contacted. It has often been the case that a new owner has been found or the present owner persuaded to repair or sympathetically restore a building previously at risk from a variety of causes.

Some of the buildings involved were Shireoaks Station, Wiseton Lodges, Drakeholes and properties in Bridgegate and Carolgate, East Retford. Following the successes achieved in the City of Nottingham the restoration of 114/116 St. Stephens Road, Sneinton, was begun and studies for Manor Farm, Colwick and 34 High Street, Arnold, carried out.

The Trust were remembered in the will of the late Miss Britton, who left her property, No.73 Main Street, Papplewick, to the Trust with the hope that the building would be restored and either sold or let in accordance with her wishes. It is the intention of the Trust to deal with the property in a manner in which she would have approved.

The 1985 Annual General Meeting was held in the Cathedral Hall, Nottingham. Following the business meeting, an illustrated talk was given by Mr. Nigel Kerr on the subject of the re-listing of buildings of architectural and historic interest within the County. The matter was of particular interest as the work of re-listing has gone ahead closely watched by the Trust which has given advice on a number of buildings as appropriate.

The Technical Advisers were invited to comment on one hundred and sixteen planning applications during the year, mainly concerning buildings in Conservation Areas or listed buildings elsewhere.

Following a resolution made at the last A.G.M. the Trust made formal objection to the demolition of Lambert's Factory, Nottingham, at the Public Inquiry held into the matter, and the Inspector's decision is awaited with interest.

Following the Norman Summers Memorial Fund appeal, work was carried out at Wollaton Hall to restore the dovecote in the Stable Block, and this was officially opened by the Lord Mayor in May. A plaque to the memory of Norman Summers will be placed in the new exhibition space adjacent to the dovecote.

The newsletter has been printed in its new format with the help of voluntary technical assistance and contributions are welcome from members and friends. It is planned to publish the newsletter in two forms in the future, one as a "glossy" publication with some academic content, and the other as a more "chatty" news bulletin.

The Trust ran two coach trips during the year. One was to Rockingham Castle and the other was a visit to three buildings designed by the architect James Paine (1717-1789). The Paine buildings were Doncaster Mansion House, Wadworth Hall and Sandbeck Hall, near Malby. At Sandbeck Lord Scarborough welcomed the party and with Lady Scarborough gave a conducted tour of the house.

The Trust was pleased to welcome Mrs. Jennifer Jenkins to the County in June to inspect some of the work carried out by the Trust, including Greens Gardens, Barton-in-Fabis dovecote and Forest and Newstead Lodges. The Chairman of the County Council and the Lord Mayor of Nottingham also joined the party at various times, who all expressed their support for the work the Trust was doing and had done. Mrs. Jenkins has since moved from English Heritage to become Chairman of the National Trust.

The work of measuring and recording buildings and building up an archive of buildings within the county has not proceeded as well as was hoped. Volunteers to help organise and carry out this work are urgently required.
