REPORT ON THE YEAR'S ACTIVITIES

The work of the Trust has continued during the past year now directed by two Committees: the Revolving Fund Committee and the Technical Panel, both under the overall guidance of the Council of Management.

The Revolving Fund Committee, which has been mostly meeting at Newark, has completed and is continually updating a County-wide list of buildings at risk, from either neglect or overdevelopment. The Trust's involvement has resulted in a number of historic buildings being saved and over-enthusiastic redevelopment schemes being modified. As a last resort, the Trust now has the capability to acquire the buildings themselves and restore them in an appropriate manner for re-sale.

The Trust has also been instrumental in having some buildings, which were overlooked in the recent re-survey, listed as being of architectural or historic interest, thus gaining them some protection from loss or damage.

Some of the schemes in which the Trust has been involved are the following:

Warden's Cottage, Misson - this house was purchased by the Trust after many years of neglect and its restoration and re-sale is being negotiated with interested parties.

Shireoaks Station - the Trust has made a nominal offer to buy the station from B.R. and to find a new use for it.

Cottages at Willoughby-on-the-Wolds - a joint scheme to ensure the future of the cottages has been agreed with the owner.

Reevills Yard, Nottingham - a development scheme was prepared in conjunction with the City Council.

Carolgate, Retford - a feasibility study for future development was carried out.

Manor Farm, Colwick - following the Trust's intervention, an acceptable scheme for redevelopment was produced and is now being carried out.

The Technical Panel has held regular meetings to discuss the details of historic buildings and to arrange events, coach trips, slide evenings and the publication of the Newsletter and News Bulletin.

The Technical Advisers commented on one hundred and sixty planning applications which affected historic buildings and their settings and gave written or verbal evidence at three Planning Inquiries.

Two coach trips were organised during the year; the first was to Ilam and Locko Park in Derbyshire and the second was a tour of buildings in the County which had been restored and brought back into use. Both trips were well attended and enjoyed.

During the year, two Newsletters and three News Bulletins were produced and circulated to members. The Newsletter sub-committee, now replaced by the Technical Panel, is to be congratulated on the high standard of the Newsletter and thanks expressed to the contributors of articles for publication.

Slide evenings were held at Hickling, Shireoaks and Worksop Manor Lodge. The evenings are very useful as a way for members of the Trust to meet each other in an informal manner and exchange ideas. Thanks are due to those members who allowed us to use their homes as meeting places for these events.

A grant of £250 was made towards the restoration of a monument to the architect Robert Smythson, which stands in the Church at Wollaton. This was especially appropriate as Wollaton Hall, of which Smythson was architect, is celebrating its 400th anniversary year.

The 1987 A.G.M. was held in the new Mansfield Civic Centre. Following the business meeting, an illustrated talk was given by Mr. Robert Harrison, Conservation Officer to the City of Nottingham, about work being carried out in the City.

REPORT OF THE AUDITOR TO THE MEMBERS OF THE NOTTINGHAMSHIRE BUILDING PRESERVATION TRUST LIMITED
